





## Percentage Distribution of Palestinian Population by Country of Residence, At the End of 2024






# Registered Live Births and Deaths in Palestine\* by Region/Governorate and Sex, 2023


Population Pyramid in Palestine, End Year 2024

Average Household Size in Palestine by Region, 2023





#### Indicators of Registered Marriage and Divorce Cases at Shari'a Courts and Churches in Palestine by Governorate, 2022





Unemployment Rate among labour Force Participants of Individuals Aged 15 Years and above in the West Bank by Sex and Years of Schooling 2020-2024


Unemployment Rate of Participants in Labour Force (15 Years and above) in the West Bank by Age Groups, 2024

#### Percentage Distribution of Employed Persons (15 Years and above) in the West Bank by Place of Work, 2020-2024




#### Percentage Distribution of Per Capita Expenditure in the West Bank on Commodities and Services Groups, 2023




#### Percentage Distribution of Per Capita Expenditure in Gaza Strip on Commodities and Services Groups, (Q1 – Q3, 2023)




Poverty Percentages among Individuals in the West Bank According to Monthly Consumption Patterns (2009-2011, 2017, 2023)








#### Physicians and Beds per 1000 Population in the West Bank, 2012-2023\*




















#### Percentage Distribution of the Imported Electricity in Palestine by Region, 2023


